The Recent Spanish Cinema Series is an initiative of the Spanish Institute of Cinematography and Audiovisual Arts (ICAA) with the American Cinematheque and EGEDA US.



LOCATION

The Egyptian Theatre , major Hollywood landmark & the American Cinematheque's permanent home, was the venue for the first-ever Hollywood premiere.
