Los Angeles Premiere: MARSHLAND LA ISLA MINIMA 2014, Outsider Pictures, 105 min, Spain, Dir: Alberto Rodriguez Spain's democracy was still on wobbly legs in 1980, particularly in the backwater of Andalusia where this tense crime drama is set. City policemen Juan (Javier Gutiérrez) and Pedro (Raúl Arévalo) are dispatched to the depressed rural area to investigate the disappearance of two sisters; the cops' differing backgrounds – one a ruthless veteran, the other an idealistic rookie – lead to increasingly unsettling discoveries.

Winner of 10 Goya Awards, including Best Film, Director, Lead Actor (Gutiérrez) and Cinematography (Alex Catalán's aerial shots are truly dazzling).
